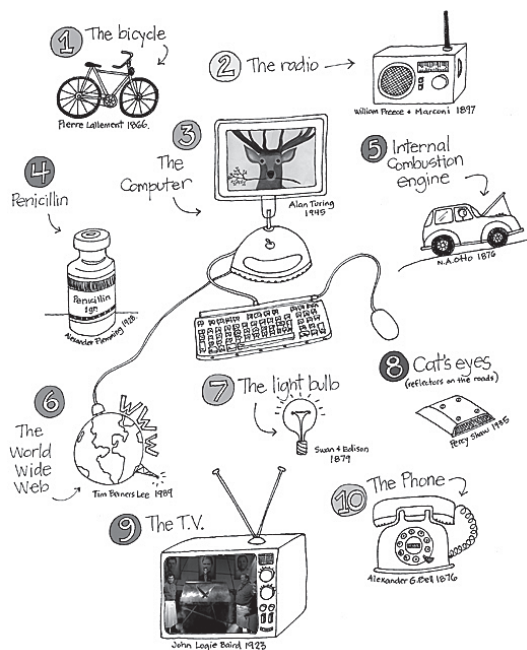


What is the best invention of all time?
