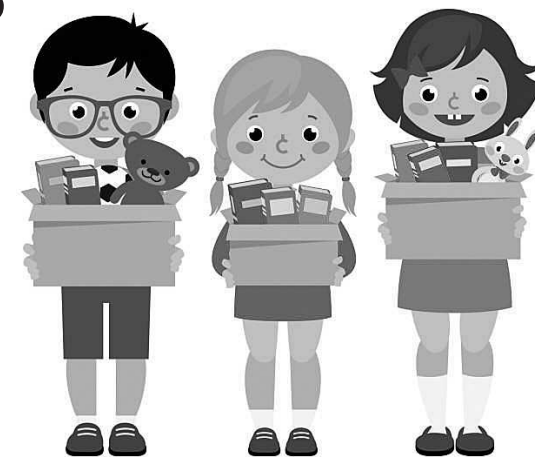
Kamrin Allen, 5th, Jonesville Middle, Mrs. Austin
