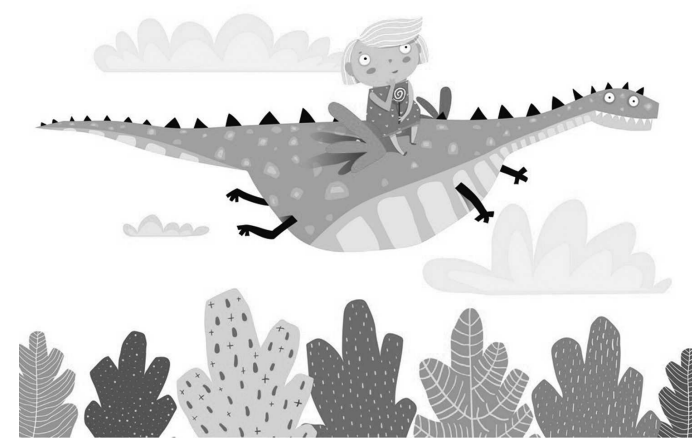
**Tucker Sizemore, 5th, Jonesville Middle, Mrs. Brown**
